## Autumn Term 2021

Welcome back and a big welcome to our new Reception children

**This term our topic is OUR WORLD**

Children take part in a creative curriculum and learn through practical activities in the classroom and in our outdoor learning environment. All lessons are differentiated and resourced to meet the needs of all our learners in Class One.

**Literacy** - Stories with familiar settings, traditional tales, poetry and information texts.

**Phonics** - Phases 2, 3, and 4. Children also take part in shared reading sessions, guided reading and individual reading. Reading books will be changed on **Monday, Wednesday and Friday**.

**Numeracy** - Numbers and place value, addition, subtraction, measures and geometry.

**Science** - Seasons and months of the year and animals including humans.

**RE** - 'Being Special: Where do we belong?'; Harvest, Christmas. Year 1/2 Wedding.

**Topic** - **History, Geography, Art and DT, Music**. This includes family and local village history; Scorton village and our geographical location; the continents including the Polar Regions; drawing, painting, printing, sculpture, textiles and collage including colour mixing and the work of the artist Kandinsky. In Music we will sing and perform, play instruments and listen to music.

**Computing** - E-safety and technology in our lives.
