This term our topic is OUR WORLD

Children take part in a creative curriculum and learn through practical activities in the classroom and in our outdoor learning environment. All lessons are well differentiated and resourced, meeting the needs of all our learners in class one.

Literacy - Looking at different stories with familiar settings, traditional tales and information texts.

Phonics - Phases 2, 3. Children also take part in shared reading sessions, guided reading and individual reading. Reading books will be changed on a Monday, Tuesday and Friday.

Numeracy - Numbers and place value, addition, subtraction, measures and geometry.

Science - Seasonal change as well as animals including humans

Computing - E-safety and technology in our lives.

Topic - History, Geography, Art and DT. This term, children will be learning about their geographical position as learning about different continents and the Polar Regions.

RE - New beginnings, Harvest, Christmas. Belonging, visit from Rev Yvonne, vestments, visits to Church. The Church: a special place for Christians, Belonging to the Family of God.
