### Summer Production - 'Mystery at Magpie Manor'

Our KS2 Summer Production this year is on Tuesday 26th and Wednesday 27th June at 6pm in Scorton Village Hall. Class 3 and 4 children are taking part. Class 3 children are our choir and Class 4 children have the acting parts. All our children will watch the dress rehearsal on Friday 22nd June. Children in Class 3 and 4 will need to be at the hall for 5.45pm and will need collecting at 7pm. Class 4 children have costumes and Class 3 children should wear smart summer clothes for the performance. The production is set in the 1920's so dresses for girls and shorts/trousers and a shirt for boys would work well. It is warm in the village hall so dress to be comfortable and cool.
