Whole School visit to Fountains Abbey and Studley Royal Water Gardens We had a wonderful day on our whole school visit on Tuesday. Class 1 explored the Abbey and grounds on a sensory trail workshop—a particular highlight was ringing the bell at the water mill. Class 2 went pond dipping finding amazing creatures: pond skaters, water boatmen and even a newt. They loved the hidden nooks and crannies of the Abbey buildings. Class 3 set out on a mammal to minibeast hunt with magnifying pots and binoculars. Discovering the herd of red deer was amazing. In the afternoon they visited the water gardens, Abbey and folly art installations. Class 4 enjoyed their art workshop day—comparing Georgian and modern follies and using this as inspiration for their own collage and clay work.

Online safety for children All children in Class 4 received letters yesterday alerting them to online safety issues for children particularly as they prepare to transfer to Secondary School.
