

Highlights from this week in school:

Class 1 have explored 2D shapes and their properties in Maths and have practised their addition number bonds. They have been learning about the Great Fire of London and practising songs and drama for their Class Assembly. Mrs Reynolds was very impressed with the high quality of their homework this week.





Class 2 enjoyed a Materials Hunt around the school grounds in Science. In RE they have been learning about the Jewish faith and the Mezuzah. In Maths they have learnt about 2D and 3D shapes. In English they are starting to write their own stories based on the Gingerbread Man. In Music they had fun performing in groups.



















Class 3 have completed the final sections of their Dragon Reports. In Maths they have been working on multiplication and division and in RE they explored adult and infant Baptism. Class 4 have been working on addition and subtraction of fractions. In English they are writing their Sherlock Holmes inspired stories.
