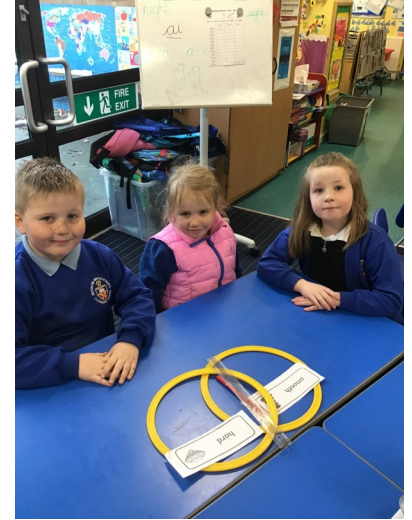

Highlights from Class 1:

Class 1 have enjoyed Science work on materials and are planning to make their recycling monsters next week. As part of World Book Day they wrote book reviews. In Maths they have continued worked on shape and have enjoyed a range of number games in 'Friday Fun Maths'.



Highlights from Class 2: In Maths they have been finding fractions of amounts including half, quarter and three quarters. In English they have written questions about the Great Fire of London and edited these to check they are punctuated correctly. In Science they have sorted objects according to their properties. Year 1 children from both classes and Year 2 have explored the Jewish festival of Hanukkah and worked together to sequence the story.



Highlights from Class 3:

Class 3 have started English work on their new text, 'The Rainbow Bear' by Michael Morpurgo. In Maths they have explored perimeter and in PE they have enjoyed Tennis. In Art they have completed their North American totem poles. Featured below are some of their great World Book Day costumes.
