This week in Class 1 we have worked hard on our phonics and reading and have enjoyed creative work linked to fireworks. We have also learnt about firework safety. Year 1 children have been partitioning numbers in Maths. We have enjoyed role play in our new Vets and had fun at break times in the autumn leaves with our friends and Year 6 buddies.






























**This week in Class 2** we have been writing instructions for how to keep safe near fireworks. In Maths we have been partitioning and working on number bonds to 10. In Science we carried out an investigation into our hand span sizes. Both Year 1 and Year 2 children from Class 1 and 2 share their RE lessons and worked on drama linked to the story of Jesus choosing Matthew to be a disciple. In Computing we inserted an image into Word. In Art we worked on portraits inspired by the artist Andy Warhol.


















This week in Class 3 we have enjoyed our History work on the stone age and researched life in a stone age village at Skara Brae. In English we have written descriptions of the Woolly Mammoth and instructions based on the text 'How to Wash a Mammoth'. In Maths we have worked on column subtraction and recall of our Times Tables. In RE we reflected on what is meant by forgiveness and linked this to the creation story. In PE we enjoyed basketball and Dance and in Music we started a new unit on 'Blues' music.
