The theme is Counting Poems and we have been learning poems as a whole class and for some groups as a homework challenge and sharing these with one another.

In Science we have explored animals and their offspring. In Art we have investigated colour mixing to create autumn pictures. In Music we have used instruments to maintain a steady beat. We have explored our school grounds on our autumn walk. We are also preparing for our Class Assembly.



In Class 2 we have enjoyed using our new school laptops to develop our computing skills and use of the mouse. We have been developing our use of the number line in Maths. In Science we have learnt about animals and their offspring and collaborated together to discuss, match and sort these.



<u>Wedding in Year 1 and Year 2</u> All our Year 1 and Year 2 children from Class 1 and 2 are working together to plan a wedding as part of their RE work on celebrations. **Please see the letter sent home in book bags last Friday.** The wedding will be in St Mary's Church, Bolton-on-Swale on Thursday 10th October. We have asked in the letter that children bring some 'wedding' clothes to change into on that day.

STEM Club in Year 1 and Year 2, after school on Thursday with Mrs Dutton and Miss Cooper, is proving a great success. The children have enjoyed Science investigations using sweets to explore colour mixing, dissolving and chemical reactions.



<u>In Class 3</u> we have been improving our knowledge of Times Tables. In Science we have been excited to explore circuits in our Electricity topic. In PE we are developing our Tag Rugby skills and in Design Technology we have developed our 3D sculpture skills. Class 3 took home a letter last Friday in their book bags about their Stone Age Workshop morning on Tuesday 8th October. We are requesting a contribution on Parent Pay to fund this and asking children to come dressed in Stone Aged themed colours for their role play activities.





In Class 4 we have developed our place value in Maths by partitioning numbers up to 10 million and counting in powers of 10. We have been editing and improving our descriptive writing and researching the life of Winston Churchill, his leadership style and impact on the Second World War. In Science we have studied the theories of Copernicus and Galileo and the heliocentric system. Class 4 took home letters in their book bags last Friday about their visit to Eden Camp Second World War Museum on Friday 11th October. We are requesting a contribution on Parent Pay to fund this.

<u>Green Howard's Regimental Museum, Richmond</u> As part of our work with the North Yorkshire Service Community our Class 4 children have been invited to sing once again at the Annual Service Pupils Service in Ripon Cathedral on Wednesday 6th November (more details to follow). In preparation for this we were invited to send 4 pupils to research our nominated Second World War soldier.
