<u>Planning ahead</u> School swimming lessons in the summer term. Once again all our children in Year 1-Year 6 will have a course of 10 swimming lessons with instructors at Richmond School. This happens each year your child is in school.

**In Class 1** we have really enjoyed creating our giant spider sculpture as part of our Art Work and inspired by the work of the sculptor Louise Bourgeois. In English we are working on traditional tales and in Geography we have been exploring Kenya.



**In Class 2** we have explored the story of The Three Little Pigs and linked this to our Science work on Materials. In Geography we are looking at life in Kenya and in Art we completed our 3D sculpture pictures focussing on the Tree of Life.





**In Class 3** we have explored climate zones in India as part of our Geography. In Maths we continue to focus on learning Times Tables to x12 and on multiplication and division. In English we are writing our travel brochures to India. In PE we are working on Gymnastics and Hockey skills. Some our class represented our school in the Y3/4 Dodgeball competition at Richmond School.



**In Class 4** we have been multiplying and dividing fractions and finding fractions of amounts. In English we have been researching the ancient Maya game of Pok-a-Tok. In Science we have studied Isaac Newton's colour spectrum. The girls have enjoyed a cricket taster session-with a coach from Richmondshire County Cricket Club.
