**In Class 1:** Mrs Reynolds says, 'We worked hard on our Remembrance Day activities; creating our class poppy wreath for our whole school Act of Remembrance and reflecting in art work and prayers. We are also enjoying our Science work where we grouped animals into carnivores, herbivores and omnivores and researched animal groups. We explored the story of the gunpowder plot and created our own firework inspired art. We continue to enjoy our outdoor learning.'























**In Class 2:** Mrs Dutton and Mrs Smith say: 'As well as working on our Class Assembly, we have created our own Remembrance wreath and reflected. In Science we have been sorting animals into groups and in Maths we have explored properties of 2D and 3D shapes. Pictured below we are composing in Music.'

**In Class 3:** Mrs Wright says: 'In Maths we have worked on formal written methods for subtraction and applied this to problem solving. In English we continue to enjoy our class reader, Romans on the Rampage by Jeremy Strong. Our PE unit is focusing on Health, Well being and Mindfulness. In Computing we have been using commands to program a screen turtle. We continue to make excellent progress with our violins and cellos in class music lessons. Well done to our Y3/4 hockey team who represented our school very well in the area tournament showing skill, resilience and determination.





In Class 4: Mr Ramsbottom says: 'We have been learning about the work of the naturalist John Muir and the creation of National Parks and protected green spaces. We have also been preparing for our residential visit to Marrick Priory. We were proud to represent our school at the Festival of Remembrance for North Yorkshire Service Children in Ripon Cathedral where we sang so well. We had an opportunity to tour the cathedral and see some of the poppy art work we had helped to create.'
