<u>Our Service of Remembrance to mark the end of World War 1</u> This week our children have taken part in a range of activities to commemorate this significant national event. We have focussed on the importance of remembering; in thanksgiving, to show respect and to celebrate the work of our armed forces today, particularly in our school and community. In our Act of Remembrance we laid poppy wreaths made by the children; held a 2 minute silence; shared First World War poetry; listened to the 'Last Post' played by Harvey Wilkinson on his trumpet; sang 'The National Anthem' and placed 17 named poppies in our Peace Garden to commemorate the 17 soldiers from Scorton village who lost their lives during World War 1.
