## Reading books

Please send reading books and the reading record into school each day. Reading books will be changed on a **Monday, Wednesday and Friday**, if completed and recorded by an adult in the reading record.

## Spellings

Spellings will be given on a **Monday** and children will have a chance to show what they have learnt the following **Monday** in small groups. **Please support your child to complete three spelling attempts each week as this does help them to correctly spell during independent writing. Spelling books need to be returned to school every Monday.**

## Homework

Homework will be given every Friday in a 'homework book' and will be due in by **Wednesday** of the following week. Please keep homework books in their packets.

## PE

We will be focussing on multi skills and gymnastics. Please send P.E kit for both indoor and outdoor sessions, including suitable PE trainers for going on the playground or field. P.E days can change from time to time therefore P.E kits need to be brought into school on a **Monday** and will sent home again on a **Friday**.

## Topic: Our World

Numeracy sessions will cover: number and place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and geometry.

Our Literacy focus this term will be: stories with familiar settings, poetry and information texts. In addition, there will be opportunities to develop writing for different purposes across the curriculum.

During science sessions, we will explore seasonal change as well as animals including humans. Computing sessions will focus on e-safety, technology in our lives, multimedia and programming.

Topic sessions will encompass: history, geography, music, art and design technology. This term, we will be developing map reading skills by identifying countries that form the United Kingdom as well as the seven continents. Later in the term, we will focus more closely on the polar regions and look forward to producing artwork on this theme.

RE sessions will focus on Bible stories and special times in the Church's year.
