Welcome back and a big welcome to our new reception.

This term our topic is OUR WORLD

Children take part in a creative curriculum and learn through practical activities in the classroom and in our outdoor learning environment. All lessons are differentiated and resourced, meeting the needs of all our learners in class one.

Literacy - Looking at different stories with familiar settings, traditional tales and information texts.

Phonics - Phases 2, 3. Children also take part in shared reading sessions, guided reading and individual reading. Reading books will be changed on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday.

Numeracy - Numbers and place value, addition, subtraction, measures and geometry.

Science - Seasonal change as well as animals including humans

Computing - E-safety and technology in our lives.

Topic - History, Geography, Art and DT. This term, children will be learning about their geographical position and learning about different continents and the Polar Regions. In art we will look at colour mixing and apply this technique in other areas of the topic curriculum.

RE - New beginnings, Harvest, Christmas. We will also look at Bible stories.

Spellings Year One

These will be given out every Monday. Children will have a spelling quiz the following Monday.
